Autumn brings out the State's gifted musicians

Two seasons a year, Autumn and Spring, Recitals Australia presents their series of Wednesday Lunch Hour Concerts commencing at 12.10 and 1.10pm in Adelaide's Pilgrim Church, 12 Flinders Street, Adelaide.

This year, their popular 40-minute Autumn concerts recommence on Wednesday 8 March and will continue until 28 June.

"Recitals Australia's Wednesday Lunch Hour Concerts allow us to provide an important concert platform for a large number of artists, ranging from young and talented students to emerging and established professional musicians," says President, David Lockett. "In presenting these concerts we make classical music accessible to a large part of community at very affordable prices."

The Autumn 2006 Season will feature a number of Adelaide Eisteddfod prize-winners including 9 year-old pianist Haruka Fakuda, and pianists Alice Wharldall and Albert Wu, who will all make their Recitals Australia début.

Other instrumentalists who can be heard during the Autumn Season include: Katherine Howard, Louise Mackay and Ruth Saffir (cello), Linda Pirie (flute), Denny Vuong and David Oliver (guitars), Carolyn Lam and Ingrid Homburg (violin), Gabriella Bond and William Newbery (viola).

Some of the sublime works those instrumentalists will perform are: César Franck's celebrated Sonata for Violin and Piano arranged for Cello and Piano, Beethoven's Cello Sonatas, Arnold Bax's Viola Sonata, Elgar's Cello Concerto and Bach's works for unaccompanied viola.

As is normally the case, the piano will reign strong throughout this Season with solo recitals by pianists Marianna Grynychuk, Fr Christopher Horvat, Larissa Schneider, Peter Schodde, Janice Jialou Tan and others. Programs will feature composers: Bach, Beethoven, Chopin, Liszt, Mozart and Rachmaninov.

In 2006, Recitals Australia will again reward the most outstanding young performers with a cash prize of \$1,000, together with an invitation to perform in a special Award Winners' Recital. The June 28 concert will feature winners from the Spring 2005 season.

Tickets for the two-concerts (with tea and coffee available in between) are \$5 Adult and \$3 Concession. For the dedicated concert-goer, Recitals Australia also offers season tickets costing \$50 Adult and \$30 Concession, representing a significant saving.
